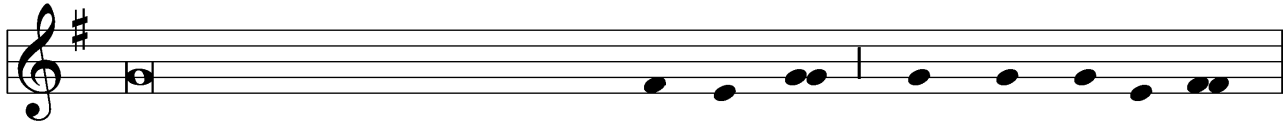

CLOSE COMMUNION AT TRINITY

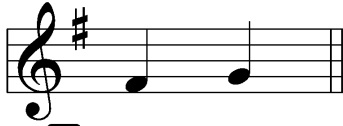

The congregation assembles in silence.

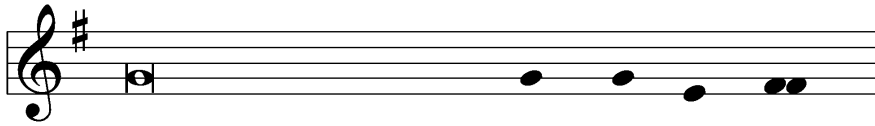

and none shall make them afraid.”*

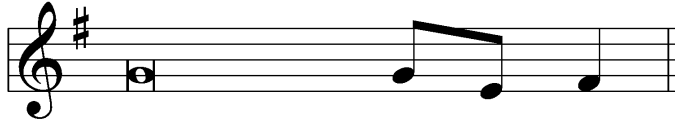
